WHEREAS, a loyal and highly professional employee, Patty Douglas handled membership concerns, produced monthly newsletters, and managed finances for the Virginia Angus Association and the annual Virginia Beef Cattle Improvement Association bull sales, among other organizations and events; and

WHEREAS, Patty Douglas earned numerous awards and accolades throughout her career; she was inducted into the Virginia Angus Association Hall of Merit in 1998 and has earned the nickname The First Lady of Virginia Angus; now, therefore, be it
