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### VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 46.2-625 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by 3 adding a section numbered 46.2-602.4, relating to titling and registration of non-conventional 4 vehicles; penalty.

### Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 1. That § 46.2-625 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia 9 is amended by adding a section numbered 46.2-602.4 as follows: 10

§ 46.2-602.4. Titling and registration of off-road motorcycle converted to on-road use.

A. For the purpose of this section:

"Converter" means a person who, through the act of conversion, alters an off-road motorcycle for 12 13 on-road use on the highways by the addition, substitution, or removal of motor vehicle equipment, creating a motor vehicle to which Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards for new motorcycles will 14 15 become applicable at the time of the conversion. A converter shall be considered a manufacturer responsible under 49 U.S.C. § 30112 for compliance of the motorcycle with Federal Motor Vehicle 16 Safety Standards and the certification of compliance required by those standards. 17 18

"Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards" means the standards prescribed by 49 C.F.R. Part 571.

19 "Manufacturer" means a person manufacturing or assembling motor vehicles or motor vehicle 20 equipment.

21 "Motor vehicle equipment" means (i) any system, part, or component of a motor vehicle as originally 22 manufactured or (ii) any similar part or component manufactured or sold for replacement or 23 improvement of a system, part, or component, or as an accessory or addition to a motor vehicle.

24 "Off-road motorcycle converted to on-road use" means every off-road motorcycle that has been 25 converted for use on the public highways with the addition of such necessary equipment to meet all 26 applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards for new motorcycles for the year in which it is 27 converted.

28 B. Each converter shall certify in accordance with the requirements of subsection E that the off-road 29 motorcycle converted to on-road use meets all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards for 30 new motorcycles for the year in which it is converted. If the converter is unavailable or unknown, the 31 owner shall certify that the converter is unavailable or unknown and that he assumes responsibility for 32 all duties and corresponding liabilities under the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Act. If a converter or 33 owner fails or refuses to provide the required certification, the vehicle shall remain an off-road 34 *motorcycle*.

35 C. Each converter, or owner if the converter is unavailable or unknown, shall permanently affix to 36 each vehicle a label containing the following: (i) the name of manufacturer, (ii) the month and year of 37 manufacture, (iii) the gross vehicle weight rating, (iv) the gross axle weight rating, (v) certification that 38 the vehicle conforms to all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards in effect on the date of 39 manufacture in the year in which it is converted, (vi) the vehicle identification number, and (vii) the 40 motorcycle vehicle classification. Such label shall meet the requirements set forth in 49 C.F.R. § 567.4.

41 D. Upon receipt of an application and such evidence of ownership as required by the Commissioner 42 pursuant to § 46.2-625, the Department shall issue a certificate of title for an off-road motorcycle 43 converted to on-road use. The first certificate of title issued for an off-road motorcycle converted to 44 on-road use shall be an original certificate of title, regardless of the submission of a Virginia certificate 45 of title issued for the off-road motorcycle prior to conversion.

E. No off-road motorcycle converted to on-road use shall be registered or operated on the highways 46 47 of the Commonwealth until the owner submits to the Department, upon a form approved and furnished by the Department, (i) certification that the motor vehicle has passed the motor vehicle safety inspection **48** 49 subsequent to the conversion; (ii) certification from the converter, or owner if the converter is 50 unavailable or unknown, that the motor vehicle meets all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety 51 Standards; and (iii) certification that the motor vehicle has been labeled in accordance with subsection 52 С.

53 F. When necessary and upon application, the Department shall issue temporary trip permits in 54 accordance with § 46.2-651 for the purpose of transporting the off-road motorcycle converted to 55 on-road use to and from an official motor vehicle safety inspection station.

56 G. Notwithstanding §§ 46.2-105 and 46.2-605, any certification required by this section found to be **SB1003ER** 

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57 knowingly given falsely is punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.

58 § 46.2-625. Specially constructed, reconstructed, replica, converted electric, or foreign vehicles.

59 If a vehicle for which the registration or a certificate of title is applied is (i) a specially constructed, 60 reconstructed, replica, converted electric, or foreign vehicle or (ii) off-road motorcycle converted to 61 on-road use, the fact shall be stated in the application and, in the case of any foreign vehicle registered outside the Commonwealth, the owner shall present to the Department the certificate of title and 62 registration card or other evidence of registration as he may have. The Commissioner may require such 63 other evidence of ownership as he may deem advisable and promulgate regulations establishing what 64 additional evidence of ownership, if any, shall be required for titling and registration of (i) specially 65 66 constructed, reconstructed, replica, converted electric, or foreign vehicles or (ii) off-road motorcycles 67 converted to on-road use. All titles and registrations for specially constructed, reconstructed, replica, and converted electric vehicles and off-road motorcycles converted to on-road use shall be branded with the words "specially constructed," "reconstructed," "replica,"  $\Theta$  "converted electric," or "off-road motorcycle converted to on-road use," as appropriate. Titles for vehicles that are both converted electric vehicles 68 69 70 71 and reconstructed vehicles shall be branded with the words "reconstructed" and "converted electric."
