11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. § 1. That the Secretary of Natural Resources, in cooperation with the Department of Game and
13	Inland Fisheries and the Marine Resources Commission, shall develop a plan for the consolidation of
14	the law-enforcement functions of these two agencies under the authority of the Department of Game and
15	Inland Fisheries. The consolidation plan shall take into account (i) the cost efficiencies of such a plan;
16 17	(ii) the potential for redirecting financial savings from such consolidation to other high priority responsibilities identified by the agencies and their boards; (iii) gaps and duplication of training, tasks,
18	and enforcement services, and opportunities for improved service delivery; (iv) maximizing the
19	protection of Virginia's natural resources; and (v) additional new funding sources available to support
20	the consolidation, if needed. The law-enforcement consolidation plan shall include an implementation
21	strategy that addresses the following management concerns: (a) what activities constitute "law
22	enforcement"; (b) the training, coordination, and deployment of law-enforcement personnel; (c)
23	workload management based on seasonal priorities; and (d) optimizing communication among
24	law-enforcement personnel in such areas as the regulation of fishing (recreational and commercial),
25	boating safety, and habitat and bottomlands
26	protection.
27	§ 2. The Secretary of Natural Resources shall submit the law-enforcement consolidation plan to the
