In addition to such priority allocation of bonds under § 1, the General Assembly hereby appropriates \$63.0 million in nongeneral fund authority for federal grant funds to the Virginia Department of Veterans Services for the Northern Virginia Veterans Care Center project.

§ 3. The Northern Virginia Veterans Care Center project is authorized up to a 230-bed facility.
