## 1 VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER 2 An Act to amend and reenact § 33.2-1400 of the Code of Virginia, relating to chairmanship of the 3 Virginia-North Carolina Interstate High-Speed Rail Compact. 4 [S 815] 5 Approved 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 7 1. That § 33.2-1400 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 8 § 33.2-1400. Virginia-North Carolina Interstate High-Speed Rail Compact. 9 § 1. Short title. 10 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Virginia-North Carolina Interstate High-Speed Rail 11 Compact. 12 § 2. Compact established. Pursuant to the invitation in 49 U.S.C. § 24101 Interstate Compacts, in which the United States 13 Congress grants consent to states with an interest in a specific form, route, or corridor of intercity 14 15 passenger rail service (including high-speed rail service) to enter into interstate compacts, there is hereby established the Virginia-North Carolina Interstate High-Speed Rail Compact. 16 § 3. Agreement. 17 18 The Commonwealth of Virginia and the State of North Carolina agree, upon adoption of this 19 compact: 1. To study, develop, and promote a plan for the design, construction, financing, and operation of 20 21 interstate high-speed rail service through and between points in the Commonwealth of Virginia and the 22 State of North Carolina and adjacent states; 23 2. To coordinate efforts to establish high-speed rail service at the federal, state, and local 24 governmental levels; 25 3. To advocate for federal funding to support the establishment of high-speed interstate rail service 26 within and through Virginia and North Carolina and to receive federal funds made available for rail 27 development; and 28 4. To provide funding and resources to the Virginia-North Carolina High-Speed Rail Compact 29 Commission from funds that are or may become available and are appropriated for that purpose. 30 § 4. Commission established; appointment and terms of members; chairman; reports; Commission 31 funds: staff. 32 The Virginia-North Carolina High-Speed Rail Compact Commission is hereby established as a 33 regional instrumentality and a common agency of each signatory party, empowered in a manner 34 hereinafter set forth to carry out the purposes of the Compact. The Virginia members of the Commission shall be appointed as follows: three members of the House 35 of Delegates appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, and two members of the Senate 36 appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules. The North Carolina members of the Commission shall be 37 38 composed of five members as follows: two members of the Senate appointed by the General Assembly 39 upon recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, two members of the House of 40 Representatives appointed by the General Assembly upon recommendation of the Speaker of the House 41 of Representatives, and one appointed by the Governor. 42 The chairman of A Co-Chairman to the Commission shall be chosen by the Virginia members of the 43 Commission from among its Virginia membership for a term of one year, and shall alternate between 44 the member states. 45 A Co-Chairman to the Commission shall be chosen by the North Carolina members of the Commission from among its North Caroline membership for a term of one year. 46 The Commission shall meet at least twice each year, at least once in Virginia and once in North 47 48 Carolina, and shall issue a report of its activities each year. The Commission may utilize, for its operation and expenses, funds appropriated to it therefor by the 49 50 legislatures of Virginia and North Carolina or received from federal sources. Virginia members of the Commission shall receive compensation and reimbursement for the 51 necessary and actual expenses as provided in the general appropriations act; North Carolina members of 52 53 the Commission shall receive per diem, subsistence and travel allowances in accordance with applicable 54 statutes of North Carolina, as appropriate. 55 Primary staff to the Commission shall be provided by the Virginia Department of Rail and Public 56 Transportation and the North Carolina Department of Transportation.
