6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That §§ 2.2-2525 and 2.2-2529 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 2.2-2525. (Expires July 1, 2019) Membership; terms; quorum; meetings.**

9 The Commission shall have a total membership of 21 nonlegislative citizen members to be appointed
10 as follows: four nonlegislative citizen members, of whom two shall be persons with disabilities, one
11 shall be the relative of a citizen of the Commonwealth with a disability, and one shall be a provider of
12 services to citizens of the Commonwealth with disabilities or an advocate for persons with disabilities or
13 for services to such persons to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; six nonlegislative
14 citizen members, of whom three shall be persons with disabilities, one shall be the relative of a citizen
15 of the Commonwealth with a disability, and two shall be providers of services to citizens of the
16 Commonwealth with disabilities or an advocate for persons with disabilities or for services to such
17 persons to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates; and 11 nonlegislative citizen
18 members, of whom three shall be persons with disabilities, one shall be an individual *who is receiving*
19 *or has received* services in a state hospital operated by the Department of Behavioral Health and
20 Developmental Services, one shall be an individual *who is receiving or has received* services in a state
21 ~~training center~~ *or private intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disability*, one shall
22 be a *current or former* resident of a nursing facility, two shall be the relatives of citizens of the
23 Commonwealth with disabilities, and three shall be providers of services to citizens of the
24 Commonwealth with disabilities or an advocate for persons with disabilities or for services to such
25 persons to be appointed by the Governor. Nonlegislative citizen members of the Commission shall be
26 citizens of the Commonwealth.

27 Nonlegislative citizen members shall serve a term of four years; however, no nonlegislative citizen
28 member shall serve more than two consecutive four-year terms. Appointments to fill vacancies, other
29 than by expiration of a term, shall be for the unexpired terms. Vacancies shall be filled in the same
30 manner as the original appointments. All members may be reappointed. The remainder of any term to
31 which a member is appointed to fill a vacancy shall not constitute a term in determining the member's
32 eligibility for reappointment.

33 The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership. A majority
34 of the members shall constitute a quorum. The Commission shall meet not less than four times each
35 year. The meetings of the Commission shall be held at the call of the chairman or whenever the
36 majority of the members so request.
