4. Title: Criminal background check for transfer of firearms; exemption for holders of concealed handgun per

5. Summary: The proposed legislation provides that a licensed firearms dealer does not have to have a criminal background check performed to determine a person's eligibility to purchase a firearm if the purchaser possesses a valid concealed handgun permit and presents a photo-ID issued by an agency of the Commonwealth or the Department of Defense.

Fiscal Implications: According to the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission's fiscal impact statement for the proposed legislation, this bill is not expected to increase the future state-responsible (prison) space needs in state adult correctional facilities of the Department of Corrections.
