3. Committee: Transportation.

4. Title: Virginia's World War II Heritage Alliance Route; VDOT to indicate by placing markers, etc.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Transportation to place and maintain appropriate markers indicating "Virginia's World War II Heritage Alliance Route," as designated by the Virginia World War II Heritage Alliance and promoted by the Virginia Tourism Corporation.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate, See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill will require the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to place and maintain appropriate markers indicating Virginia's World War II Heritage Alliance Route. The bill does not speak to how the costs associated with the placement and maintenance of these signs are to be funded, however, any costs related to the signs are to be borne by the requesting locality. The number of signs required is determined by VDOT in consultation with the affected localities; VDOT estimates a cost of approximately \$1,000 per sign.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: VDOT; Affected localities.
