8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> HB1300 states that each county and city shall be reimbursed in full by the proper political party committee for the costs of the presidential primary. The bill does not state whether the Department of Elections will be reimbursed for the costs it incurs during the presidential primary. For the 2012 presidential primary, Item 470 J. of Chapter 2, Special Session I, 2012 Acts of Assembly provided up to \$3.0 million to reimburse localities and the State Board of Elections for the presidential primary expenses. Out of that amount, up to \$270,000 was allocated to reimburse the State Board of Elections.
