4. Title: General Assembly Conflicts of Interests Act; revolving door prohibition.

5. Summary: The bill prohibits any legislator, during the one year following his termination of service as a legislator, from accepting an appointment to or employment with a governmental agency. The bill exempts appointments by the Governor to serve as a Governor's Secretary from this one-year prohibition.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: None.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill establishes a policy change with no direct or identifiable fiscal impact on state government operations.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All state agencies; Legislators of the Commonwealth.
