4. Title: Flashing lights on motor vehicles; move over law

5. Summary: Specifies that vehicles assisting with the management of roadside and traffic incidents, or performing traffic management services along public highways may be equipped with flashing, blinking, or alternating amber warning lights as allowed for other vehicles used for towing or servicing disabled vehicles. Virginia's "move over" law applies to such vehicles.
