5. Summary: Provides that the expiration date on a form of identification offered for voting identification purposes shall not be considered when determining the validity of that form of identification.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Elections, House Bill 1375 does not have a state fiscal impact. The proposed legislation amends subsection B of § 24.2-643, Code of Virginia, requiring an officer of election to not consider the expiration date of any of the acceptable forms of identification listed in subsection B when determining its validity.
