5.	<b>Summary:</b> Permits local electoral boards to appoint a general registrar who is a qualified voter of a county or city adjacent to the county or city for which he is appointed. Current law requires the general registrar to be a qualified voter of the county or city for which he is appointed. The bill leaves unchanged the provision allowing a city electoral board to appoint a qualified voter of the county in which the city is wholly contained to serve as the city general registrar.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> According to the Department of Elections, House Bill 1473 is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.
