4. Title: State Police; reporting hate crimes.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation includes within the definition of "hate crime" a criminal act committed against a person because of sexual orientation or gender identification, and requires the reporting of the commission of such crime to the State Police. It also requires State Police to include crimes as defined by the amended "hate crime" term on its central repository for the collection and analysis of information regarding hate crimes.
