8. Fiscal Implications: Information about Safe Sleep environments consistent with the American Academy of Pediatrics is readily available on multiple websites, including VDH. Preliminary fiscal impact includes \$25,000 annually for the printing and distribution of required information to maternity care providers, or for the development of electronic marketing and media materials that could replace printed brochures. This will be paid for using 100 percent federal funds. There is sufficient nongeneral fund appropriation to cover this item.
