4. Title: Business entities; reserved names.

5. Summary: Business entities; reserved names. Allows the owner of a reserved name for a stock or nonstock corporation, limited liability company, business trust, or limited partnership to use the name for any of these forms of business entity regardless of the business entity type. The measure also deletes from various name reservation statutes the requirement that a business entity designation be included in the application for a reserved name.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Fiscal impact estimates on the State Corporation Commission are minimal and final.

8. Fiscal Implications: The State Corporation Commission will incur minimal fiscal impact relating to some minor computer programming expenses.
