4. Title: DNA data bank; State Police to verify receipt of samples from persons on the Sex Offender Registry.

Summary: The legislation requires the Department of State Police to verify receipt of DNA samples by the Department of Forensic Science for persons required to register on the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry. The bill also requires the State Police to obtain a DNA sample for such persons if one has not been received by the Department of Forensic Science.
