3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Virginia Public Procurement Act; job order contracts and design professional contracts.

5. Summary: Increases the maximum project fee amount for job order contracting (JOC) from \$400,000 to \$500,000 for single task orders and from \$2 million to \$5 million for the sum of all projects performed in a one-year contract term. The bill also (i) decreases the population threshold for localities for the procurement of architectural and engineering services from 80,000 to 78,000 and (ii) increases the single project limit for architectural and engineering services for such localities from \$2 million to \$2.5 million and the aggregate limit for projects performed in a one-year contract term from \$5 million to \$6 million.

The engrossed House substitute limits the sum of all projects performed in a one-year contract term to \$5 million, with a limit of \$6 million for localities. The introduced version of the bill provided a limit of \$4 million for all projects in a one-year contract term, and a limit of \$10 million for localities.
