4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; bed and breakfast licenses

5. Summary: Expands the privileges of a bed and breakfast license by authorizing the licensee to permit the consumption of lawfully acquired alcoholic beverages (i) in bedrooms or private guest rooms by persons to whom overnight lodging is being provided or (ii) in other designated areas of the bed and breakfast establishment, provided such areas are under the control of the licensee. The bill also defines “other designated areas” for the purposes of § 4.1-206 of the Code of Virginia.
