3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: Notification of suicidal tendencies.

5. Summary: Requires the board of visitors or other governing body of every public institution of higher education to develop and implement policies that advise students, faculty, and staff, including residence hall staff, of the proper procedures for notifying the threat assessment team when a student has exhibited suicidal tendencies or behavior.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. No Fiscal Impact: Preliminary. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any administrative efforts required to address the provisions of this legislation can be accommodated within existing resources of the higher education institutions

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia public institutions of higher education.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: The substitute bill removes the provision that the board establish policies to define circumstances under which the parents of students exhibiting suicidal tendencies shall be notified and requirement that the institution record its reasons in instances when it does not immediately notify parents of students exhibiting such behavior.
