4. Title: Virginia Port Authority; requirements for gubernatorial appointees to the Board of Commissioners.

5. Summary: The bill would specify experience requirements for the 11 members appointed by the Governor to serve on the Board of Commissioners of the Virginia Port Authority (VPA). The bill requires one member with maritime shipping experience, one member with seaport operations experience, one member with transportation experience, one member with agriculture experience, two members with business administration or finance experience, two members with distribution or manufacturing experience, and three members with mining, marketing, or legal experience.

Currently, the members appointed by the Governor are to have executive-level experience and represent one of the following industries: agriculture, distribution and warehousing, manufacturing, logistics and transportation, mining, marketing, legal, financial, or transportation infrastructure.

8. Fiscal Implications: The bill would require VPA board members to have specific experience prior to their appointment by the Governor. The bill is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.
