**4. Title:** Firearms show; State Police list of vendors or exhibitors.

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation requires a promoter of a firearms show to include in his list of vendors or exhibitors submitted to State Police information regarding whether a vendor or exhibitor was selling or transferring a firearm and the vendor or exhibitor's dealer identification number, if applicable.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** Although insufficient data exists to determine the fiscal impact due to this proposal, the proposed legislation could result in more persons being convicted of Class 3 misdemeanor, which does not carry jail time but can result in a fine up to \$500. Any revenue from fines is deposited into the Literary Fund. The bill has no material impact on the Department of State Police.
