**5. Summary:** Prohibits campaign fundraising on and after the first day of a special session of the General Assembly through adjournment sine die of that session. Currently, campaign fundraising is prohibited only during regular sessions of the General Assembly.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** No state fiscal impact.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Elections indicates that this bill does not create a state fiscal impact.
