5. Summary: Increases from 11 to 14 the number of nonlegislative citizen members on the Board of Veterans Services, thereby increasing the total membership of the Board from 19 to 22. The bill contains a technical amendment.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Veterans Services, the proposal will have an impact of about \$1,875 per year for travel and expenses (5 meetings X 3 new members X \$125 per meeting for travel and expenses). The Department states it can absorb the estimated cost with existing resources.
