4. Title: Board of Education; annual report; condition and needs of public education in the Commonwealth.

5. Summary: The proposed legislation would change the date by which the Board of Education is required to submit to the Governor and the General Assembly a report on the condition and needs of public education in the Commonwealth and identify any school divisions and schools that have failed to meet the existing prescribed standards of quality. The bill would shift the due date from November 15 to December 1.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Some of the data included in the report are not available in time for the Board to approve the report prior to its November meeting, which is after the November 15 deadline. By moving the deadline, the Board can submit a more accurate report to the Governor and the General Assembly. The change in the due date will not impact state finances.
