2. Patron: Delegate Pillion

3. Committee: Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Establish a civil penalty for smoking in a motor vehicle with a minor present

5. Summary: This bill provides that any person who smokes in a motor vehicle, whether in motion or at rest, when a minor under the age of eight is in the motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty of \$100, but no demerit points or court costs. The offense may be charged on a uniform traffic summons.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate (see Section 8)

8. Fiscal Implications: Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate how many violations could result from this proposed legislation. Resulting fines would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
