3. Committee: Health, Welfare and Institutions

4. Title: Prohibits practitioners dispensing controlled substances.

5. Summary: Prohibits a practitioner of the healing arts from dispensing controlled substances unless licensed by the Board of Pharmacy to sell controlled substances. The bill requires facilities from which practitioners of the healing arts dispense controlled substances to obtain a permit from the Board.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill as engrossed would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The Department of Health Professions has stated that this would not impact operations or workload. The inspections of facilities are already being performed and any impact would be on the facility permit holder, therefore there is no impact on the agency.
