3. Committee: Education

4. Title: Requires documentation of dismissal on academic transcript if student is dismissed for sexual assault, code of conduct, or honor code violations.

5. Summary: Requires public institutions of higher education to document the dismissal of any student who has been dismissed for violation of the institution's sexual misconduct policy, student code of conduct, or institution's honor code on such student's academic transcript. Institutions must also notify and receive confirmation from each student that communicates understanding that such dismissals will be documented on his or her academic transcript.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that any administrative efforts required to address the provisions of this legislation can be accommodated within existing resources of the higher education institutions.
