**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Conservation and Recreation, this bill has no fiscal impact. This legislation authorizes the department to convey a 15-foot wide, permanent, nonexclusive right-of-way easement across its property in the Horsepasture District of Henry County (along the western boundary of the future Mayo River State Park).
