**4. Title:** Community services boards and behavioral health authorities; coordination of services for veterans.

**5. Summary:** The bill requires community services boards and behavioral health authorities to designate a member of staff to coordinate the delivery of mental health services, including crisis services, to veterans in cooperation with the Department of Veterans Services, U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, and hospitals, centers, and other facilities or installations of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill simply codifies the current practice of Community Services Boards to appoint a staff member to be the primary contact to coordinate services with the Department of Veterans Services. This bill has no fiscal impact.
