4. Title: Roadside safety devices; identification numbers

5. Summary: Requires the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to ensure that certain roadside safety devices installed on or after July 1, 2016, be stamped with identification numbers by the manufacturer.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to VDOT, contracts already issued for bid and those in process which carry forward through July 1, 2016, would require a work order to mandate the "stamped" requirement only if the manufacturer is not already providing a permanent marking of the device. Any fiscal implications would be absorbed within the costs of the projects installing these roadside safety devices.
