A second enactment provides this change to be effective beginning July 1, 2016.

Fiscal implications: According to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), there are no direct fiscal implications resulting from this legislation as it just requires existing dedicated funding for paving to be used for unpaved highways carrying more than 50 vehicles to also be used for improvements to these roads without paving.
