- 8. Fiscal Implications: According to the State Board of Elections (SBE), implementing House Bill 694 would require modifying the Virginia Election and Registration Information System (VERIS) to accept registrants at 16 years of age while adapting the pollbook to indicate ineligibility, similar to what must currently be done for 17-year olds in municipalities with May elections. The SBE estimates there will be one-time costs to modify VERIS (\$25,000) and revise the voter registration application and update training and guidance documents (\$2,200). There will also be an ongoing cost of \$6,000 for printing and distribution of the application form.
