2. Patron: Miller

3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Purchase, etc., of vapor products by minors; sale or distribution of vapor products, etc.

5. Summary: Prohibits the sale of vapor products to a minor and the purchase or possession of vapor products by a minor. Current law prohibits the sale of nicotine vapor products to a minor and the purchase or possession of nicotine vapor products by a minor. The bill also prohibits (i) the sale or distribution of liquid nicotine in a liquid nicotine container; (ii) the sale or distribution of liquid nicotine, a vapor product, or a vapor product solution within 1,000 feet of the premises of any place he knows or has a reason to know is a child day center or a primary, secondary, or high school; (iii) the sale or distribution of liquid nicotine or a vapor product solution that contains any artificial or natural flavor that imparts a characterizing flavor other than the flavor of tobacco; and (iv) the distribution of any free samples of liquid nicotine, vapor products, or vapor product solutions. Any person who violates a prohibition is subject to a civil penalty in the amount of \$500 for a first violation, \$1,000 for a second violation, and \$2,500 for a third or subsequent violation. Civil penalties shall be paid into the state treasury.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: The fiscal impact due to the proposal cannot be determined. However, all civil penalties are to be paid into the state treasury. The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control states it can absorb the minimal fiscal impact anticipated due to the proposal with existing appropriations.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Courts statewide, Alcoholic Beverage Control.
