**4. Title:** The Advisory Committee on Juvenile Justice; delinquency prevention.

**5. Summary:** The legislation provides for the addition of delinquency prevention to the Committee on Juvenile Justice's responsibilities (Committee), and amends the current title of the Committee to "The Advisory Committee on Juvenile Justice and Prevention."

The bill also grants the Committee authority to serve as an advisory committee as may be required by federal or state laws or programs administered by the Department of Criminal Justice Services. The bill also adds the Commissioner of Health to the Committee's membership, and allows for the Committee's membership to be adjusted as necessary to fulfill the requirements of laws or programs as related to the activities of the Committee.
