**3. Committee:** Rehabilitation and Social Services

**4. Title:** Post-adoption services

**5. Summary:** The proposed legislation requires the State Registrar of Vital Records, when issuing a new certificate of birth pursuant to an adoption, to provide adoptive parents with a document listing all post-adoption services available to adoptive families. The bill requires the Department of Social Services to create, annually update, and make this document available on its website.

Fiscal Implications:** While there would be some minimal staff time associated with creating and maintaining the required documents; Department of Social Services does not expect it to be significant.
