**4. Title:** State Board for Community Colleges; policy for the award of academic credit for military training.

**5. Summary:** Requires the State Board for Community Colleges to adopt, no later than December 31, 2015, a policy for the award of academic credit to any student enrolled at a comprehensive community college who has successfully completed a military training course or program as part of his military service that is applicable to the student's certificate of degree requirements and is recommended for academic credit by a national higher education association that provides academic credit recommendations for military training courses or programs, noted on the student's military transcript issued by any of the armed forces of the United States, or otherwise documented in writing by any of the armed forces of the United States.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Virginia Community College System, there is no fiscal impact for this legislation.
