3. Committee: Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources

4. Title: State resident licenses; military dependents.

5. Summary: This bill extends the entitlement to obtain a state resident license to hunt, trap, or fish to the dependents of members of the armed forces. Current law entitles members of the armed forces to obtain such a license. The bill also makes technical amendments.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries does not estimate a substantial increase or decrease in resident versus non-resident license sales as a result of this legislation. A minimal increased revenue impact may result from the legislation, if the dependents pursue licensure. However, the department anticipates that this population is relatively small in number.
