2. Patron: Senator Petersen

3. Committee: Transportation

4. Title: Limit the opening and closing of motor vehicle doors in traffic

5. Summary: This bill requires drivers and passengers to wait for a reasonable opportunity to open vehicle doors on the side adjacent to moving traffic. A violation constitutes a traffic infraction punishable by a fine of not more than \$100 with no demerit points being awarded. Law-enforcement officers, school guards, firefighters, and rescue squad members are exempted from this legislation when performing their duties.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate (see Section 8)

8. Fiscal Implications: Currently, there is insufficient information available to reliably estimate the number of violations and the amount of revenue that could result from this proposed legislation. Any fines collected under these provisions would be deposited into the Literary Fund.
