4. Title: Exemptions from boating safety education requirements.

5. Summary: This bill exempts motorboat operators born prior to July 1, 1972, and who are residents of Virginia, from having to demonstrate compliance with boating safety education requirements before operating a motorboat. The bill removes the current exemption from such requirements for persons renting a boat to operate a motorboat on Virginia waters.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a fiscal impact to the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. The department does not charge a fee for classroom boating safety education courses.
