11 12	1. That § 30-111 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12 13	§ 30-111. Disclosure form. A. (Effective from January 1, 2016, until July 1, 2016) The disclosure form to be used for filings
13 14	required by subsections A and B of § 30-110 shall be substantially similar to the following.
15	A. (Effective July 1, 2016) The disclosure form to be used for filings required by subsections A and
16	B of § 30-110 shall be substantially similar to the following. All completed forms shall be filed
17	electronically with the Council in accordance with the standards approved by it pursuant to § 30-356.

24	"Business" means a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, firm, enterprise, franchise,
25	association, trust or foundation, or any other individual or entity carrying on a business or profession,
26	whether or not for profit.
27	"Close financial association" means an association in which the filer shares significant financial
28 29	involvement with an individual and the filer would reasonably be expected to be aware of the
29 30	individual's business activities and would have access to the necessary records either directly or through the individual. "Close financial association" does not mean an association based on (i) the receipt of
31	retirement benefits or deferred compensation from a business by which the legislator is no longer

"Relative" means the donee's spouse, child, 61 62 uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, or first cousin; a person to whom the donee is engaged to be married; the 63 donee's or his spouse's parent, grandparent, grandchild, brother, sister, step-parent, step-grandparent, 64 step-grandchild, step-brother, or step-sister; or the donee's brother's or sister's spouse. "Personal friend" 65 does not include any person that the filer knows or has reason to know is (a) a lobbyist registered pursuant to Article 3 (§ 2.2-418 et seq.) of Chapter 4 of Title 2.2 or (b) a lobbyist's principal as defined 66 67 in § 2.2-419.

The disclosure of a lobbyist relationship shall not (a) 76 77 constitute a waiver of any attorney-client or other privilege, (b) require a waiver of any attorney-client 78 or other privilege for a third party, or (c) be required where a member or member-elect is employed or 79 engaged by a person and such person also employs or engages a person in a lobbyist relationship so 80 long as the member or member-elect has no financial interest in the lobbyist relationship.

587 B. Any legislator who knowingly and intentionally makes a false statement of a material fact on the
588 Statement of Economic Interests is guilty of a Class 5 felony and shall be subject to disciplinary action
589 for such violations by the house in which the legislator sits.

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590 C. The Statement of Economic Interests of all members of each house shall be reviewed by the 591 Council. If a legislator's Statement is found to be inadequate as filed, the legislator shall be notified in 592 writing and directed to file an amended Statement correcting the indicated deficiencies, and a time shall 593 be set within which such amendment shall be filed. If the Statement of Economic Interests, in either its 594 original or amended form, is found to be adequate as filed, the legislator's filing shall be deemed in full 595 compliance with this section as to the information disclosed thereon.

596 D. Ten percent of the membership of a house, on the basis of newly discovered facts, may in writing 597 request the house in which those members sit, in accordance with the rules of that house, to review the 598 Statement of Economic Interests of another member of that house in order to determine the adequacy of 599 his filing. In accordance with the rules of each house, each Statement of Economic Interests shall be 600 promptly reviewed, the adequacy of the filing determined, and notice given in writing to the legislator whose Statement is in issue. Should it be determined that the Statement requires correction, 601 augmentation or revision, the legislator involved shall be directed to make the changes required within 602 603 such time as shall be set under the rules of each house.

604 If a legislator, after having been notified in writing in accordance with the rules of the house in 605 which he sits that his Statement is inadequate as filed, fails to amend his Statement so as to come into 606 compliance within the time limit set, he shall be subject to disciplinary action by the house in which he 607 sits. No legislator shall vote on any question relating to his own Statement.

608 2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or 609 commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot 610 be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter 611 665 of the Acts of Assembly of 2015 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to 612 assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the 613 necessary appropriation is \$0 for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of 614 Juvenile Justice.
