4	A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-289.01 of the Code of Virginia, relating to school service
5	providers.

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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 22.1-289.01 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 22.1-289.01. School service providers; student personal information.
12	A. For the purposes of this section:
14	"Elementary and secondary school purposes" means purposes that (i) customarily take place at the
15	direction of an elementary or secondary school, elementary or secondary school teacher, or school
16	division; (ii) aid in the administration of school activities, including instruction in the classroom or at
17	home; administrative activities; and collaboration between students, school personnel, or parents; or
18	(iii) are otherwise for the use and benefit of an elementary or secondary school.
19	"Personal profile" does not include account information that is collected and retained by a school
20	service provider and remains under control of a student, parent, or elementary or secondary school.
21	"School service" means a website, mobile application, or online service that (i) is designed and
22	marketed solely primarily for use in elementary or secondary schools; (ii) is used at the direction of
23	teachers or other employees at elementary or secondary schools; and (iii) collects and maintains, uses, or
24 25	shares student personal information. "School service" does not include a website, mobile application, or online service that is designed and marketed for use by individuals or entities generally, even if it is also
23 26	marketed for use in elementary or secondary schools.
27	"School service provider" means an entity that operates a school service pursuant to a contract with a
28	local school division in the Commonwealth.
29	"Student personal information" means information collected by a school service provider through a
30	its school service that <i>personally</i> identifies an individual student or is linked to information that
31	personally identifies an individual student. "Student personal information" does not include information
32	that is publicly available.
33	"Targeted advertising" means advertising that is presented to a student and selected on the basis of
34	information obtained or inferred over time from such student's online behavior, use of applications, or
35	sharing of student personal information. "Targeted advertising" does not include (i) advertising (a) that
36 37	is presented to a student at an online location (1) on the basis of such student's online behavior, use of
37 38	applications, or sharing of student personal information during his current visit to that online location or (2) in response to that student's request for information or feedback and (b) for which a student's
39	online activities or requests are not retained over time for the purpose of subsequent advertising or (ii)
40	adaptive learning, personalized learning, or customized education.
41	B. Each In operating a school service pursuant to a contract with a local school division, each
42	school service provider shall:
43	1. Provide clear and easy-to-understand information about the types of student personal information it
44	collects through any school service and how it maintains, uses, or shares such student personal
45	information;
46	2. Maintain a policy for the privacy of student personal information for each school service and
47 49	provide prominent notice before making material changes to its policy for the privacy of student
48 49	personal information for the relevant school service; 3. Maintain a comprehensive information security program that is reasonably designed to protect the
49 50	security, privacy, confidentiality, and integrity of student personal information and makes use of
50 51	appropriate administrative, technological, and physical safeguards;
52	4. Facilitate access to and correction of student personal information by each student whose student
53	personal information has been collected, maintained, used, or shared by the school service provider, or
54	by such student's parent, either directly or through the student's school or teacher;
55	5. Collect, maintain, use, and share student personal information only with the consent of the student
56	or, if the student is less than 18 years of age, his parent or for the purposes authorized in the contract
57	between the school division and the school service provider;

58 6. When it collects student personal information directly from the student, obtain the consent of the

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59 student or, if the student is less than 18 years of age, his parent before using student personal information in a manner that is inconsistent with its policy for the privacy of student personal 60 61 information for the relevant school service, and when it collects student personal information from an 62 individual or entity other than the student, obtain the consent of the school division before using student 63 personal information in a manner that is inconsistent with its policy for the privacy of student personal 64 information for the relevant school service; and

7. Ensure that Require any successor entity or third party with whom it contracts abides to abide by 65 its policy for the privacy of student personal information and comprehensive information security 66 program before accessing student personal information. 67

C. No In operating a school service pursuant to a contract with a local school division, no school 68 69 service provider shall knowingly:

70 1. Use or share any student personal information for the purpose of behaviorally targeting 71 advertisements to targeted advertising to students;

2. Use or share any student personal information to create a personal profile of a student other than 72 for supporting elementary and secondary school purposes authorized in the contract between by the 73 74 school division and the school service provider, with the consent of the student or, if the student is less 75 than 18 years of age, his parent, or as otherwise authorized in the contract between the school division 76 and the school service provider;

77 3. Knowingly retain Retain student personal information beyond the time period authorized in the 78 contract between the school division and the school service provider, except with the consent of the 79 student or, if the student is less than 18 years of age, his parent; or

80 4. Sell student personal information, except to the extent that such student personal information is 81 sold to or acquired by a successor entity that purchases, merges with, or otherwise acquires the school 82 service provider, subject to the provisions of subdivision B 7. 83

D. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit school service providers from using:

84 1. Using student personal information for purposes of adaptive learning, personalized learning, or 85 customized education.;

2 Using student personal information for maintaining, developing, supporting, improving, or 86 87 diagnosing the school service;

88 3. Providing recommendations for employment, school, educational, or other learning purposes 89 within a school service when such recommendation is not determined in whole or in part by payment or 90 other consideration from a third party;

91 4. Responding to a student's request for information or feedback when such information or feedback 92 is not determined in whole or in part by payment or other consideration from a third party; 93

5. Providing Internet connectivity to schools or students and their families:

94 6. Marketing educational products directly to parents if such marketing does not result from the use of student personal information obtained by the school service provider in the operation of a school 95 96 service pursuant to a contract with a local school division;

97 7. Disclosing student personal information to (i) ensure legal or regulatory compliance, (ii) protect 98 against liability, (iii) protect the security or integrity of its school service, (iv) respond to or participate 99 in judicial process, or (iv) protect the safety of school service users or other individuals;

100 8. Disclosing student personal information pursuant to a contract with a service provider, provided that the school service provider (i) contractually prohibits the service provider from using any student 101 102 personal information for any purpose other than providing the contracted service to or on behalf of the school service provider, (ii) contractually prohibits the service provider for disclosing any student personal information provided by the school service provider to any third party unless such disclosure is 103 104 permitted by subdivision 7, and (iii) requires the service provider to comply with the requirements set 105 106 forth in subsection B and prohibitions set forth in subsection C; or

9. Using student personal information for a school, educational, or employment purpose requested by 107 108 the student or the student's parent, provided that such student personal information is not used or 109 further disclosed for any other purpose. 110

E. Nothing in this section shall be construed to:

1. Impose a duty upon a provider of an electronic store, gateway, marketplace, forum, or means for 111 purchasing or downloading software or applications to review or enforce compliance with this section 112 113 with regard to any school service provider whose school service is available for purchase or download 114 on such electronic store, gateway, marketplace, forum, or means;

115 2. Impose a duty upon a provider of an interactive computer service to review or enforce compliance 116 with this section with regard to any school service provider that provides content on such an interactive 117 computer service through its school service; or

118  $\overline{3}$ . Prohibit any student from downloading, exporting, transferring, saving, or maintaining his 119 personal information, data, or documents.

E. F. No school service provider in operation on June 30, 2015 2016, shall be subject to the 120
