6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 2.2-4310.1, relating to the
7	Virginia Public Procurement Act; awards as a result of authorized enhancement or remedial
8	measures.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 2.2-4310.1 as follows:
11	§ 2.2-4310.1. Awards as a result of any authorized enhancement or remedial measure;
12	requirements.
13	A. Any enhancement or remedial measure authorized by the Governor pursuant to subsection C of
14	§ 2.2-4310 for state public bodies shall include a provision that the procurement shall be conducted in
15	accordance with such enhancement or remedial measure for businesses certified by the Department of
16	Small Business and Supplier Diversity. If such enhancement or remedial measure provides for an award
17	priority for such businesses, then the contract shall be awarded in accordance with such priority if such
18	priority business participated in the solicitation and requirements are met. If an award is not made
19	based on the foregoing, then the contract shall be awarded in accordance with the next award priority
20	and so on until a contract is awarded based on the established award priority.
21	B. If an award is not made pursuant to subsection A, the procurement award may be made without
22	regard to such enhancement or remedial measure.
