WHEREAS, Ernie Vanarsdall became the manager of the Bank of Virginia Stratford Hills branch
and later the president of Fairfield National Bank before returning to the Bank of Virginia as the head
of the bank card program; and

WHEREAS, desirous to be of service to the community, Ernie Vanarsdall joined the Henrico County
Planning Commission; representing the Brookland District, a large district with a mix of business,
industrial, and residential areas, he earned a reputation as one of the most hard-working and
knowledgeable members of the commission; and

WHEREAS, over the course of his 24-year tenure as a planning commissioner, Ernie Vanarsdall
 helped guide Henrico County through numerous periods of change and encouraged responsible growth,
 serving through three comprehensive county plans; and

WHEREAS, Ernie Vanarsdall oversaw numerous projects that benefited Henrico County residents,
including the creation of new housing subdivisions and apartment complexes; the revitalization of
sections of West Broad Street, Lakeside, and the Shops at Willow Lawn; and improvements to Libbie
Mill, CrossRidge, the Faison School, and Short Pump Town Center; and

28 WHEREAS, Ernie Vanarsdall also served Henrico County on the board of Richmond Region
29 Tourism, and he enjoyed fellowship and worship with the community as an active member of Reveille
