## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 404

WHEREAS, Sean McMurray, who is a Fellow in the American College of Healthcare Executives, has also been involved in health care governance on a statewide level as a member of the executive committee and the services board of the Virginia Hospital and Healthcare Association; and

WHEREAS, Sean McMurray is lay leader with The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints; his commitment to serving others and his church guides his life; later in 2016, he will leave his current position with Mountain States Health Alliance to become president of a Mormon mission in Fort Collins, Colorado, supervising and mentoring several hundred young missionaries; now, therefore, be it
