Celebrating the life of Luther B. Vick, Jr.

WHEREAS, Luther B. Vick, Jr., of Burrowsville, a former volunteer firefighter and longtime employee of the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, died on April 18, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Luther Vick later relocated to Prince George County and served the youth of the community by maintaining county school buses; and

WHEREAS, a devoted father, Luther Vick will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his children, Dena, Dennis, Bryan, Michael, Kevin, Sarah, and Lisa, and their families, and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Delegates hereby note with great sadness the loss of Luther B. Vick, Jr., a former firefighter and game warden and an active member of the Prince George County community; and, be it
