WHEREAS, in 2016, the Greater Manassas Volunteer Rescue Squad celebrates 50 years of providing outstanding emergency response service and emergency medical service to the people of Manassas; and WHEREAS, the Greater Manassas Volunteer Rescue Squad was founded in 1966 when a small group of volunteers began working to make their community a safer place for residents and businesses;

WHEREAS, members of the Greater Manassas Volunteer Rescue Squad readily devote many hours

Rescue Squad to be fully certified as emergency medical technician providers; all members seek to
demonstrate the Squad's core values of professionalism, respect, integrity, dedication, and excellence
every day and on every call; and

WHEREAS, all members of the Greater Manassas Volunteer Rescue Squad regularly undergo
 additional training to maintain their proficiency and certifications; and

WHEREAS, serving as a volunteer first responder is a calling for many people, including the men and women of the Greater Manassas Volunteer Rescue Squad and the members of the Squad's auxiliary unit; all of them work closely together and with the City of Manassas Fire and Rescue Department to provide support for each other in the community's best interest; and
