Commending the Newport News Rotary Club.

WHEREAS, the Newport News Rotary Club has for 20 years held a Children's Fishing Clinic, each year providing poles and instruction to teach hundreds of children to fish; and

WHEREAS, the Newport News Rotary Club has helped to plant scores of flowering trees in the Mariners' Museum Park; and

WHEREAS, the Newport News Rotary Club has helped numerous local and national charities, including the Virginia Peninsula Foodbank, Smart Beginnings of the Virginia Peninsula, Youth Challenge, the Peninsula School for Autism, the Virginia Center for Inclusive Communities, the American Cancer Society, the Salvation Army, and the American Red Cross; and

WHEREAS, the Newport News Rotary Club has participated with other Rotarians around the world in an effort to eradicate polio from the face of the earth; and
