That § 22.1-298.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:</li> <li>§ 22.1-298.1. Gegulations governing licensure.</li> <li>A. The Board of Education shall prescribe, by regulation, the requirements for the licensure of teachers and other school personnel required to hold a license. Such regulations shall include requirements for the denial, suspension, cancellation, revocation, and reinstatement of licensure. The Board of Education shall revoke the license of any person for whom it has received a notice of dismissal or resignation pursuant to subsection F of § 22.1-313 and, in the case of a person who is the subject of a founded complaint of child abuse or neglect, after all rights to any appeal provided by \$ § 3.2-1526 have been exhaused. Regardless of the authority of any other agency of the Commonwealth to approve educational programs, only the Board of Education shall have the authority to license teachers to be regularly employed by school boards, including those teachers employed to provide nursing education.</li> <li>The Board of Education shall prescribe by regulation the licensure requirements for teachers who told a five-year renewable license issued by the Board of Education may teach online courses, as defined in § 22.1-21.2.2.3 Such license shall be valid only for teaching online courses for which they are properly endorsed.</li> <li>C. 63 Association or the American Red Cross. The Board shall provide a waiver for this requirement for any person with a disability whose disability prohibits such person from completing the certification or

66 5. Every person seeking licensure with an endorsement as a teacher of the blind and visually 67 impaired shall demonstrate proficiency in reading and writing Braille; and

Every person seeking initial licensure and every person seeking renewal of a license who has not 69 completed such training shall complete training in human trafficking recognition, intervention, and prevention in accordance with curriculum guidelines developed by the Board of Education and the Department of Social Services pursuant to § 22.1-16.5. 70 71

72 E. The Board's regulations shall require that initial licensure for principals and assistant principals be 73 contingent upon passage of an assessment as prescribed by the Board.

74 F. The Board shall establish criteria in its regulations to effectuate the substitution of experiential 75 learning for coursework for those persons seeking initial licensure through an alternate route as defined 76 in Board regulations.

G. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Board may provide for the issuance of 77 78 a provisional license, valid for a period not to exceed three years, to any person who does not meet the 79 requirements of this section or any other requirement for licensure imposed by law. 80

H. The Board's licensure regulations shall also provide for licensure by reciprocity:

1. With comparable endorsement areas for those individuals holding a valid out-of-state teaching 81 license and national certification from the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards or a 82 nationally recognized certification program approved by the Board of Education. The application for 83 such individuals shall require evidence of such valid licensure and national certification and shall not 84 85 require official student transcripts;

86 2. For individuals who have obtained a valid out-of-state license, with full credentials and without 87 deficiencies, that is in force at the time the application for a Virginia license is received by the Department of Education. The individual must establish a file in the Department of Education by 88 89 submitting a complete application packet, which shall include official student transcripts. An assessment 90 of basic skills as provided in § 22.1-298.2 and service requirements shall not be imposed for these 91 licensed individuals; however, other licensing assessments, as prescribed by the Board of Education, 92 shall be required; and

93 3. The Board may include other provisions for reciprocity in its regulations.
