16104497D 1 **SENATE BILL NO. 284** 2 3 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources 4 5 6 on January 21, 2016) (Patron Prior to Substitute—Senator Lewis) A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 28.2-226 and 28.2-530 of the Code of Virginia, relating to 7 recreational oyster harvest. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 9 1. That §§ 28.2-226 and 28.2-530 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 28.2-226. Exemptions from licensing requirements. The following activities are exempt from the licensing requirements of this subtitle: 11 12 1. Except as otherwise provided by regulation, taking by dip net, hand line, or two crab pots, as much as one bushel of hard crabs and two dozen peeler crabs in any one day for personal use only. 13 14 2. Taking a maximum of one bushel of oysters in any one day for personal use, when taken by hand or with ordinary tongs during the legally prescribed oyster season on public oyster grounds open for 15 16 harvest or unleased bottom open for harvest. 3. Taking a maximum of 250 clams in any one day for personal use, when taken by hand or with 17 18 ordinary tongs. 4. Using one tank or float no greater than four feet in width and eight feet in length for shedding 19 20 crabs for personal use. 21 § 28.2-530. Taking ovsters or loading on vessel on Sunday or at night; penalty. 22 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to take oysters, from either public or private grounds, on 23 Sunday or between sunset and sunrise; nor shall any person load any vessel or boat for such purpose 24 with any oysters from any of the waters of the Commonwealth on Sunday or between sunset and 25 sunrise. 26 B. Shucking oysters taken from the public grounds other than from designated seed areas may be 27 unloaded on shore at packinghouses or loaded on trucks or motor vehicles one-half hour after sunset and 28 one-half hour before sunrise. Those ovsters which have been inspected by an officer and purchased by 29 the packer or planter, and the ovsters owned by the packer or planter, may be unloaded at any time 30 except Sunday within the discretion of the packer. 31 \vec{C} . The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not apply to (i) the taking or catching, by 32 hand during the prescribed hours of daylight on Sunday during the legally prescribed public oyster 33 harvest season on public oyster grounds open for harvest or unleased bottom open for harvest, of not more than one bushel of oysters for personal use or (ii) the taking or catching of cultured oysters during 34 35 the prescribed hours of daylight on Sunday. The presence, on board a boat or other vehicle being used 36 during any Sunday harvesting, except as part of a an oyster aquaculture operation, of any gear normally 37 associated with the harvesting of oysters other than by hand is prima facie evidence of a violation of the 38 provisions of this section. 39 A violation of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor.
